CBSC Decision 11/12-0042 CHTZ-FM re *The Biggs & Barr Show* (“The Evil that People Do” Contest)

On August 26, 2011 at approximately 8:30 am, CHTZ-FM (97.7 Htz FM, St. Catharine’s, Ontario) broadcast a contest called “The Evil that People Do”. The program is hosted by Chris Biggs and Jason Barr and their co-host “Pasty Jamie”. The contest was introduced in the following manner:

Barr: In no way do we condone –

Barr: Oh really, eh?

Biggs: Oh, so. That's unfortunate.

Barr: In no way do we condone –

Biggs: No.

Barr: -- feeding rotten chicken skin –

Biggs: To dogs.

Biggs: Nor acid to cats. Well, maybe cats.

Barr: But it sure is funny.
