## CBSC Decision 11/12-1317 CIVT-TV (CTV British Columbia) re a report on CTV News at 11:30 ("Tandoori Fire")

CTV British Columbia's broadcasts its late evening newscast began at 11:30 pm. On February 22, 2012, the newscast was anchored by Coleen Christie. The report in question was entitled "Tandoori Fire". It was the second story covered in the newscast, beginning 2 minutes 42 seconds into the broadcast. The following is a description and transcription of the report:

Christie: A huge fire has gutted a popular Indian restaurant in East Vancouver. Flames engulfed Tandoori King in the eight thousand block of Fraser Street this evening. The fire started just before six o'clock. Everyone in the building was able to get out and there were no injuries, but the blaze was large and hard to fight.

interview with Chief Rod MacDonald, Vancouver Fire: The fire got into the roof, which, uh, makes it very, very difficult to fight. We had, uh, about twelve, uh, firefighters on the interior for an attack and eventually we had to pull them out due to the heavy fire and smoke.

Christie: The Tandoori King restaurant has been in the news before. For more than a decade, the owner has been in a bitter feud with his brother-in-law who runs a restaurant called the Original Tandoori King just down the block.

Christie: Firefighters don't know the cause of the blaze. They say the roof of the building has been burnt off and water and smoke damage is extensive.
